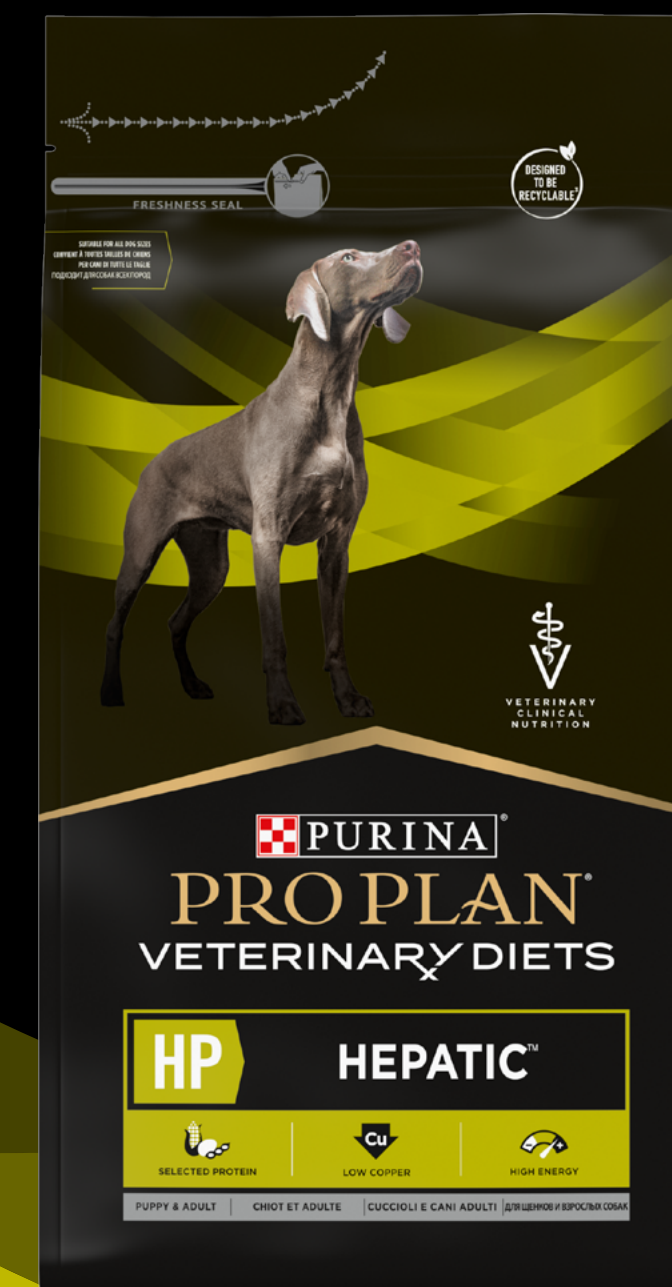

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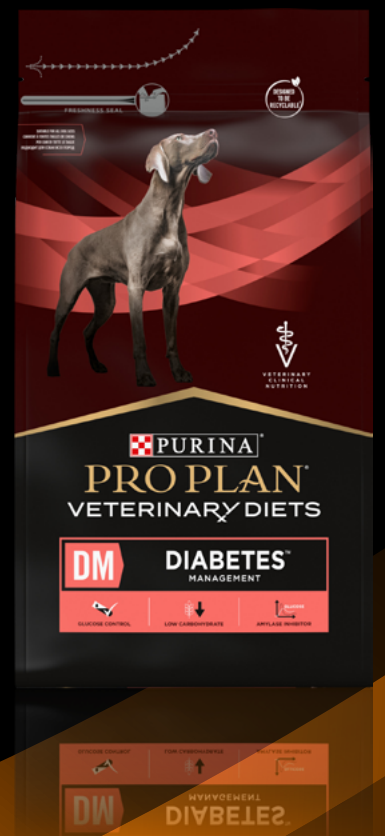

In cats, some conditions like protein-losing enteropathies, concurrent hyperlipidaemia or cats with fat malassimilation might benefit from reduced fat levels



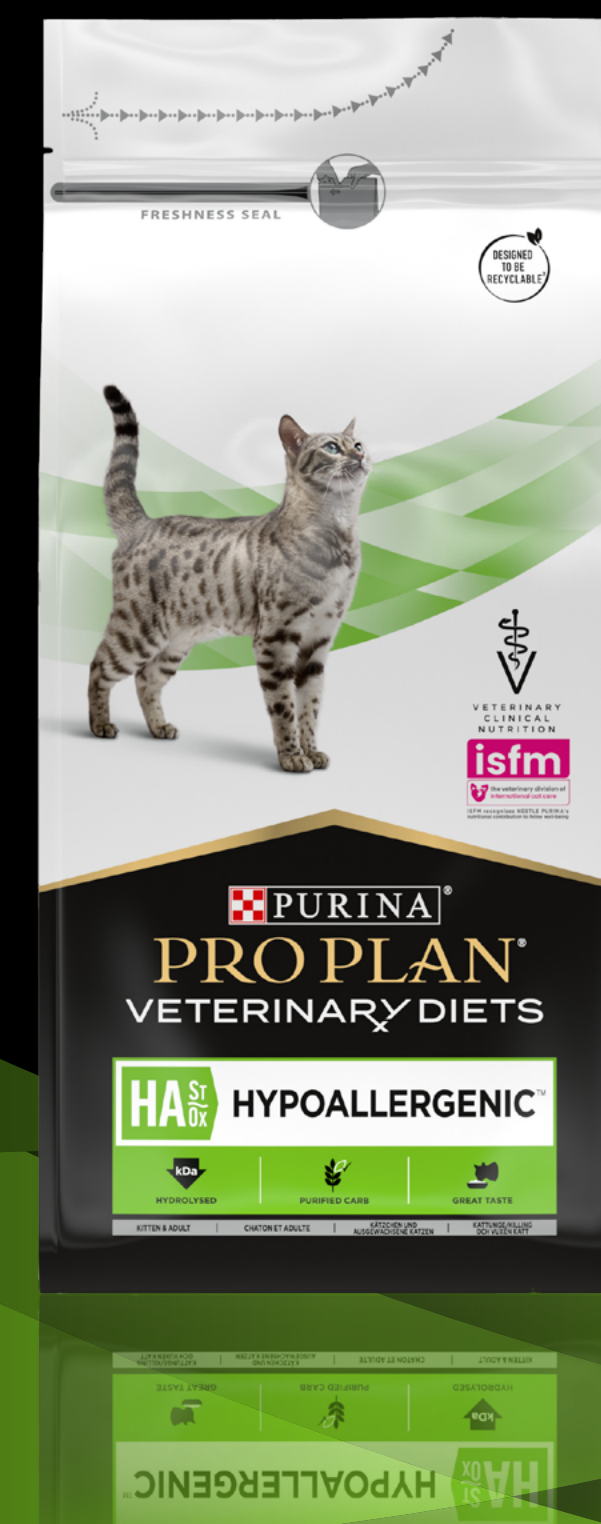
