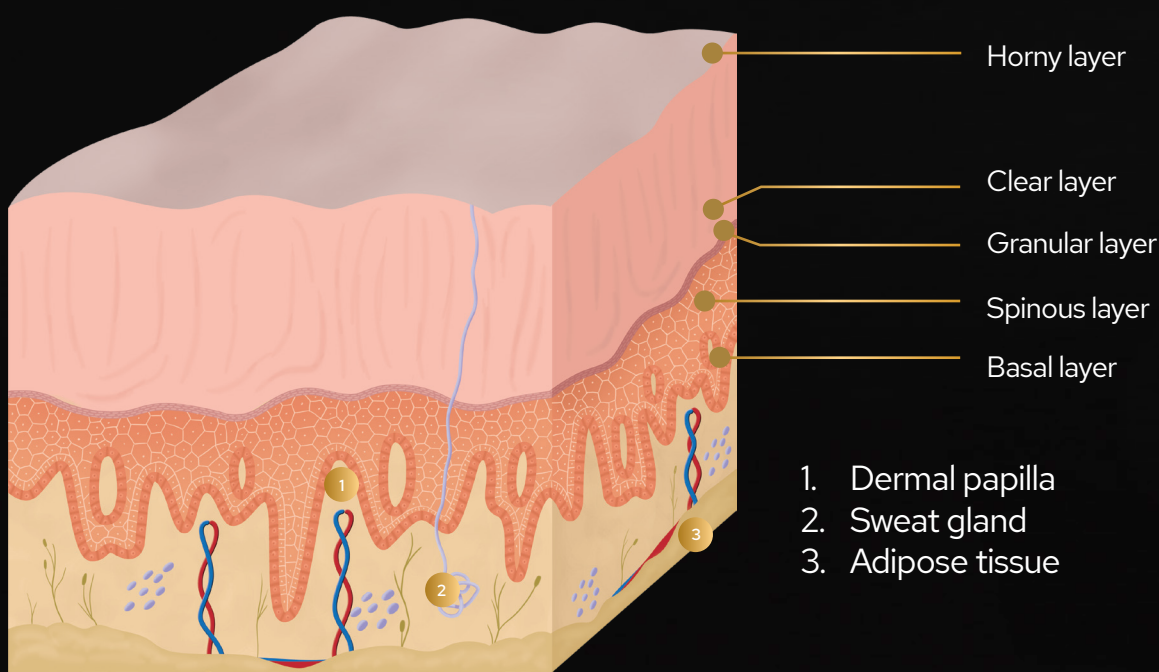

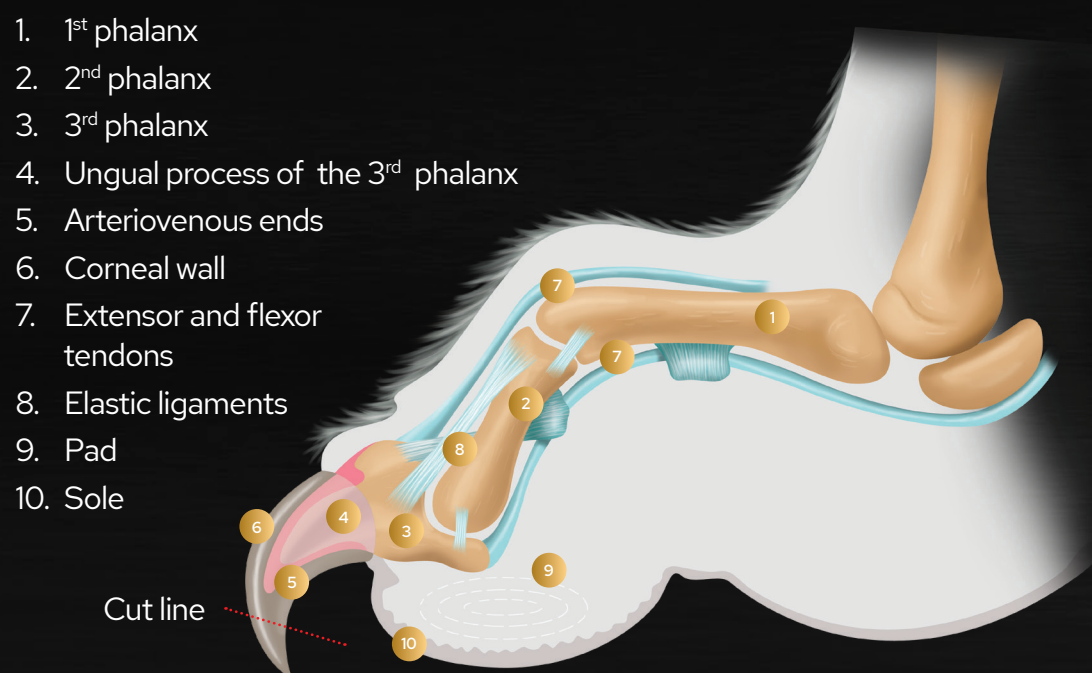
STRUCTURE OF HAIR FOLLICLE



STRUCTURE OF FOOTPAD



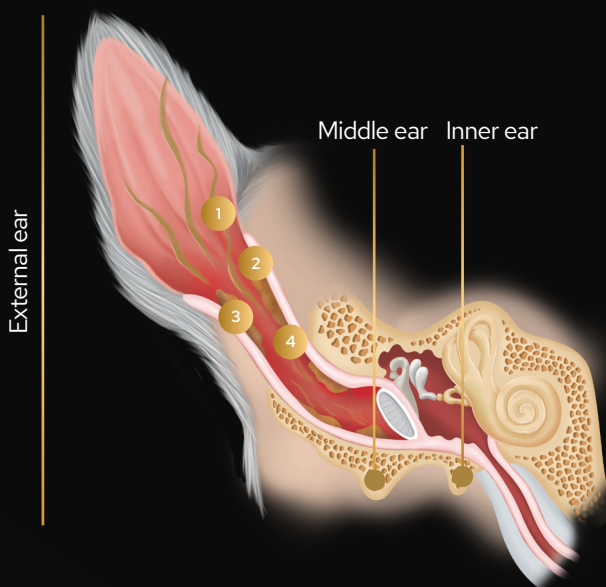

CLINICAL SIGNS OF SKIN CONDITIONS

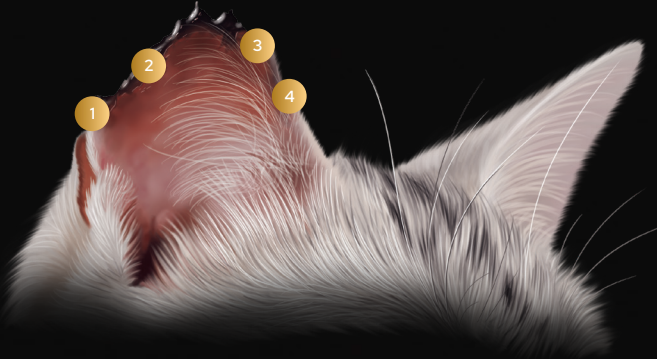
OTITIS: INNER EAR CANAL INFLAMMATION

1. Apocrine gland
2. Sebaceous gland
3. Hair follicle
4. Cutaneous muscle
5. Adipose tissue



ACTINIC KERATOSIS

1. Erythema (redness)
2. Flaking of skin
3. Crusts
4. Alopecia ((hair loss)

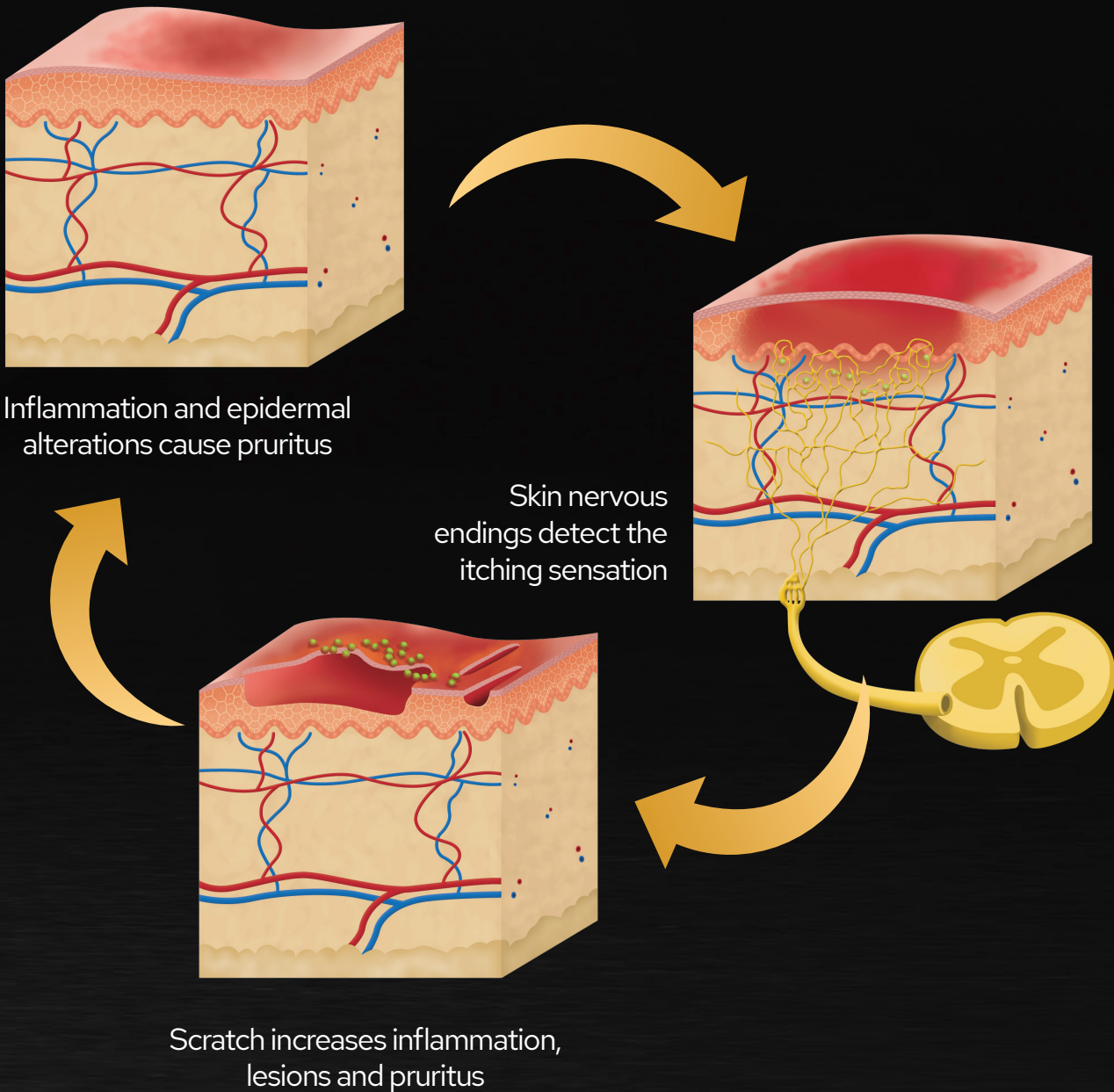


CONJUNCTIVITIS

1. Spasmodic blinking
2. Inflammation (swelling)
3. Erythema (redness)
4. Visible 3rd eyelid
5. Discharge
